This series uses a minimalist approach to convey the purity and simplicity of Teo gelato, while also demonstrating how the flavors are made.










tèo treats

This series of content explores the origins and identity of Teo through old photos. The images are arranged with an authentic and wholesome scrapbook aesthetic.






pairs with
